The specific objectives of this project are as followings;

 - In order to monitor the progress and effectively identify delays and issues, the monitoring capacity for the Master Plan needs to be developed and published in a form of a logistics annual report
 - Logistics development sector is also taken into consideration in the RGC's IDP 2015-2025
