This proposed project aims at achieving two things: (i) raising awareness of targeted participants with regard to the sharing of information on the opportunities of the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) and (ii) explore strategies to ensure that relevant stakeholders, especially the private sectors in Cambodia, are well aware of the on-going process of the ASEAN economic integration.

This proposed project is a one-year project held in 2017 and is of the projects conducted over the three-year period (2017-2019). This project is planned to be implemented in the first four areas: Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, Konpong Cham and Svay Rieng. Other areas besides the four areas will be covered in the next two years (2018 and 2019).

As stated in the objectives, this proposed project will be one of the ways to raise awareness of ASEAN in general and the key elements, challenges and opportunities of the ASEAN economic integration in particular. In addition, strategies to reap benefits from the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) will be subsequently touched upon.

Initially, since Cambodia is an ASEAN Member State and ASEAN Community has recently been realised since the end of 2015, there is a need to share and socialize the key elements, challenges and opportunities related to this Community, particularly the ASEAN Economic Community. Raising awareness of the AEC gives importance in preparing pertinent stakeholders to get ready and be able to benefit as much as possible from this integration.

Secondly, this proposed project will compose of speakers/experts from relevant ministries, including MEF, MoC, and MoLVT and entities concerned. Representative from private sectors dealing with the AEC and Special Economic Zones (SEZ) will be invited to share their insights, good practices and challenges.

At the end, a summary report of the constructive recommendations in Khmer and English versions will be compiled and disseminated.
