The project "Strengthening gender in eyes health has been developed and invested in partnership between the Ministry of women's affairs and Fred Hollow Foundation through a memorandum of understanding (MoU) which was signed by minister of ministry of women's affairs and the representative of Fred Hollow Foundation on 28th May 2014. The project will benefit the whole population (15 millions people) in Cambodia which 51.4% are women in the purpose of increasing women's access to eyes health service and participating in the eyes health sector.

15. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION: (Give reasons why this particular project is considered worthwhile.)

Cambodia is a country which blindness remain one of the major health and social problem due to some barriers accessing to eyes health services and inadequate eyes health personal. The culture and awareness are the limitation of the access to this eyes health services for women. RAAB 2007 found that the prevalence of blindness is higher among female population aged over 50 years old, accounting for 3.4% compared to 2% in male population of the same age.
