In addition, the "International Conference on Cultural Policies and Sustainable Development" (UNESCO World Conference on Cultural Policies and Sustainable Development) called "Mondiacult" of UNESCO 2022 in Mexico points to consideration of cultural arts as a separate part of setting the UN Sustainable Development Goals after 2030.
