This farm will eventually create revenue sources through pig and fish raising and fast-growing crops. Currently, The farm is in demand to build a warehouse, size 20m x 80m cost 200.000\$. In order to store machineries and agricultural products.

Department and the other line organizations to practice their skills learned, particularly in agriculture, fishery and construction.

For the farm to run efficiently and effectively, machinery and equipment is needed for all the practice and works. This is to make it authentic and practical.

The first pool of military officers to operate the farm will be chosen among the personnel from the Department of Development and a certain number from the soon-to-retire and retired officers, while apprentice will be chosen from the line organizations.
