But most of these potentials are under-exploited, leaving the bulk of horticulture products, especially vegetables, dependent on imports from neighboring countries. Most of the vegetable, locally produced and imports, are not safe for consumers as because of the overuse of chemicals. Moreover, one of the biggest constraints for vegetable farmers is lack of efficient water saving technologies.
