To provide a safe, healthy and conducive learning environment that will increase the enrollment, retention, and academic success rate of boys and girls.

The project mainly aims at enhancing pupils' learning conditions especially girls' through the construction of a block of 8 latrines for Kong Noy Primary School, and 16 latrines for Tien Primary and Secondary School- both of which are located in the suburb of the Phnom penh city and next to Kandal province- and 8 latrines for Tropang Veng Primary School located at Kandal province.primary and Secondary education level of the schools function independently in different buildings, but within the same compound.

Therefore, the implementation of the project will not only the toilet shortage problem. but also other related problems- teachers' poor productivity, pupils' poor academic performances, drop out and low self-esteem. It will contribute to increasing the enrollment, retention and academic success rate of pupils.
